*Note 1 – National D-Day Memorial

Large outdoor memorial with significant walking required across open grounds. Benches are available throughout, but shade is limited, plan for sun exposure and bring water if needed.

*Note 2 – Dixie Caverns

Tour begins with a climb up Jacob’s Ladder (48 steps) and includes a total of 342 stairs throughout the cavern. The path is steep, uneven, and sometimes slippery. Closed-toe shoes are required, and the temperature stays around 55 °F year-round so consider bringing a jacket. Not recommended for those with mobility limitations; alternate on-site activities (antique mall, rock & mineral shop) are available.

*Note 3 – Natural Bridge State Park

Path to the Bridge involves a steep downhill walk that must also be climbed on the return. A limited number of parking spaces are available at the bottom for those unable to make the walk. Transportation from parking lot to base of bridge is provided. The trail leads about 1 mile past the bridge for those that would like to see the scenic views and waterfall.
